**APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION and
STATEMENT OF POLICY AND AGREEMENT**

Angelus Academy is a non-diocesan, non-profit, private school founded by the Women's Apostolate of Youth and staffed by Catholic laypersons incorporated under the laws of the State of Virginia. Independent of the Diocese of Arlington, the school is not an agency of and is presently in no way affiliated with the Diocese of Arlington.

The Board of Trustees submits itself in obedience to the doctrines and beliefs of the Catholic Church as pronounced by the Holy Father.

The program as instituted by the trustees has as its purpose the formal Catholic education of its students in an environment respecting their intellectual capacities and their moral, emotional, social and physical well being. The end objective is to train those entrusted to our charge to be Catholic and to express their Catholic Faith constantly and consistently in thought, word, and deed. All students regardless of their family's religious affiliation will receive religious instruction and will be present at all Masses, worship services, and programs.

In the interest of making every child's educational experience a positive and fulfilling one, the trustees have further directed that this school shall be opened to children from families which are prepared to provide healthy, loving, and stimulating atmosphere at home in support of the academic and religious formation of the child. Parents agree to the following terms and conditions for participation:

1. Wholesome nurturing of the child's mind, body, and spirit by providing adequate rest, diet, recreation, etc.
2. Participating faithfully in the holy sacrifice of the Mass, the Sacraments, religious activities and household traditions that the child can link to the religious instruction received at school.
3. Communicating attentively each day with the child as a means to promote a strong moral foundation and a secure sense of love and respect.
4. Carefully monitoring the amount of time and the quality of entertainment the child is exposed to through TV, movies, video games, music, etc.
5. Providing an area and a time conducive to studying and verifying proper completion of homework assignments.
6. Being able to promptly receive a child who needs to be taken home in case of illness or disciplinary infractions.
7. Meeting their financial obligations to the school.
